Public Participation: There was no public participation

Richelle Bowman, 2nd by Lisa Gearen, moved to amend the Agenda with the following amendments, the motion carried without oppositions.

- a) Approve Mathieu Rose to attend Level 3 Production and Treatment classes in Shreveport the week of March 12-17 with lodging and meals at approximately \$1,600.00
- b) Discuss and approve upgrading the Missions SCADA System in the amount of \$37,000.00.
- c) Renewal of Phelps Correction Right of Way Contract
- d) Executive session to discuss unauthorize access to company property

Richelle Bowman, 2^{nd} by Lisa Gearen, moved to upgrade the Mission (SCADA) system in increments, starting with the 3 at the Singer Plant. The motion carried without opposition.

Lisa Gearen, 2nd by Caroll Johnson, moved to renew the 20-year contract Right of Way for the Phelps Booster Station with Phelps Correctional Institution. The motion carried without opposition

Unfinished Business:

The Board discuss and reviewed the quotes turned in for the building of the 6" fence at Fields Plant.

a) Nash Fence \$17,972.00 b) Hercules Fence Co \$13,950.00 c) BNL Co. \$13,933.32

New Business:

Lisa Gearen, 2nd by Caroll Johnson, moved to accept the engagement of Windham and Reed, CPPA as the company auditor for 2022. The motion carried without opposition.

The Board discussed the potential closing of Robert Clark Road at the camp entrance, and the affects it would have on the water district. The board requested a meter set at the entrance of Robert Clark Rd where the road has become a safety issue to gauge the water to help monitor any leaks that may occur. The Board has agreed to wait on the decision of the Police Jury, and Mr. McGrew's decision on whether or not the road will be closed.

Maintenance Report: Mathieu Rose-Operations Manager

- a) An overview of the system for January to present.
- b) The Discharge Pressure Switch had to be replaced at the Singer Plant, and an extra one was order to have on standby.
- c) Discussed and approved Blake Hines tapping the 1" water main in Fields for samples to be taken correctly at the Sample Tap POE.
- d) 1986 Trencher and the 1985 Generator is to be scrapped.
- e) An overview of water leak detection and the cost to repair. He is hoping at the end of the year to have a better understanding of what it cost the District in leak repairs.
- f) Discussed the repairs to the 2015 GMC with \$780.00 for a new headlight assembly, and \$678.48 for new seat belts.

Lisa Gearen, 2^{nd} by Richelle Bowman, moved to send an invoice to the previous employee for the repairs of the seat belts on the 2015 GMC truck in the amount of \$678.48. A policy is to be adopted that animals are not allowed to ride in company trucks. The motion carried without opposition.

Lisa Gearen, 2^{nd} by Caroll Johnson to purchase 2 Fire Hydrants in the amount of \$8,488.54. The motion carried without opposition.

Caroll Johnson, 2^{nd} by Lisa Gearen, moved to go into an executive session to discussed unauthorized access to company property. The motion carried without opposition.

Lisa Gearen, 2^{nd} by Richelle Bowman, moved to come out of executive session. The motion carried without opposition.

Lisa Gearen, 2nd by Richelle Bowman, moved to approve the hiring of an outside Information Technology contractor to review the internal system. The motion carried without opposition.
